



Specifying Anchors for Hurricane Fabric Applications

Hurricane Fabric is designed and engineered to be anchored side to side or top and bottom. It is not necessary to anchor on all sides. However, good installation practice recommends that on longer horizontal attachment spans, supplemental anchors are used on the top to prevent sagging or billowing. These supplemental anchors should be placed about 2 feet on center. Refer to our "Installation Notes" for several applications examples that illustrate the use of supplemental anchors.

When you order Hurricane Fabric, our engineering program will calculate the number of anchors according to Product Approval requirements and will not include supplemental anchors. If you desire to use supplemental anchors, please add these to your order.



In the above application, both window attachment spans are side to side and the two additional anchors top and bottom, although not required, were desired by the homeowner. In this application, the order will provide for the required 24 Clips and anchors on the sides. The optional supplemental anchors (4 or 8) should be added to your order.



In the above application, all three openings have a side to side attachment span. However, you will note that only the two longer openings have supplemental anchors on the top. The order will provide for the required 9 Clips/Anchors on each of the sides (54 total) and the optional top Clips/Anchors (6) should be added to your order.
